

ARLINGTON TOWNSHIP
Regular Meeting Minutes
May 16, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor William Colgren Jr.. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, Bregger, And DeLeo.

The minutes of the April meeting were read and approved.

Police Report-- There were (66) calls in the township with (1) Assault, (3) B&E, (1) stolen vehicle and (2) sexual assaults.

Fire Report-- There were (33) calls for the month. The new training facility has been ordered. There will be a pancake breakfast on Sat. May 26, 2012.

Supervisor Report-- Bill and Doug recently went on a road tour with Brian Cornish of the road commission.

The following sealcoat projects were proposed:

48th St. from 44th ave to 48th ave.
Hillside Drive
28th Ave from CR 215 to 52nd St
52nd St from 48th ave to 40th ave

These projects represent 5.32 miles of sealcoat at a cost of \$80,010.00 plus \$3,000.00 approximately for hot mix.

Put base paving coat on 44th Ave project started last year at a cost of \$123,290.00.

2500 yards of gravel for roads at a cost of \$21,562.00 plus 65 cents per ton to spread it.

Boom mowing at a cost of \$3,000.00 *3560 actual*

Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to due the above projects at a cost \$235,290.00 Motion Carried.

Clerk Report-- The Bangor School election passed.

Planning Commission Report-- The board will have a quarterly meeting on June 6th at 7:00 p.m. Judy Davis, long-time board member is resigning. John reported that there is some building going on in the township. Ken Dettloff is putting a digital zoning book together for us.

Hospital Report-- Robin reported that the board was recently rated highly functional. The hospital currently has a 96.4% patient satisfaction rating.
