

Arlington Township
Regular Meeting Minutes
June 20, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor, William Colgren jr.. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, Bregger, and DeLeo.

The minutes of the May 18, 2012 meeting were read and approved.

Police Report-- There were (19) assaults, (2) larcenies, and (1) arson reported during the last month

Fire Report-- None

Supervisor Report-- All roads have been salted. Bill visited Jim Borah and as a result he will clean up his business out front and put up a fence. The 44th Ave project still has unanswered questions. No gravel has yet been spread on gravel roads.

Clerk Report-- We have received our election laptop computer.

Planning Commission-- Due to a noise complaint, Bill Engle will try to reduce music noise at the Judd Farm complex. It was also suggested that he apply for a Special Use Permit to operate the facility in the future. Dale Neville has been advised that he can no longer operate his residential home repair business and trucks from his residence property on the corner of 48th and CR 215. He is now complying with that order. Mr. Mims won't cooperate with the zoning administrator or building inspector on issues with his property on M-43. Mr. McPike was present and expressed a problem with John O'Connell over a blight issue there. Pitts made a motion supported by Pugsley to appoint Joe Wooding to the Planning Commission as a replacement for Judy Davis. Motion Carried. A resident from Scott Lake expressed a concern with how John O'Connell had handled a building permit issue about a retaining wall.

Hospital Report-- South Haven Hospital, after a random inspection by Medicare, is now in full compliance with all matters.

Due to a previous title company error, Arlington Township was still shown to hold an interest in Lot 25, Block 1 of Scott Shores. Motion by Pitts, supported by DeLeo to issue a Quit Claim Deed to Jack L. and Robin R. Johnson, of 47254 Flagler Ave., Bloomingdale, Michigan, 49026 removing all interests by Arlington Township in Lot 25, Block 1, Scott Lake Shores. Motion Carried

Several political candidates were present and spoke briefly.

Maynard Kaufman spoke briefly about concerns he has with the current operation of Palisades Nuclear Power Plant. It currently is ranked one of the most unsafe power plants in the US.

Hal Manning also informed the Board that he has been approached by a company wanting to purchase Township data. Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo not to sell any Township data. Motion Carried.
