

Arlington Township
Regular Meeting Minutes
August 15, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor, William Colgren Jr.. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, and Deleo. Bregger was absent.

The minutes of the July 18, 2012 meeting were read and approved as amended.

Police Report-- None

Fire Report-- There were (57) calls with (12) in the township. There will be a pancake breakfast on Saturday during the Labor Day weekend from 7am to 11am.

Motion by Pitts supported by Pugsley to set the 2013 Fire Millage Rate at 2.7582. This will raise \$106,223.18 for the ABB Fire District and \$32,000.00 for the Lawrence Fire District. Motion Carried

Township Attorney Report-- Brian Knotek summarized a meeting that was held with John O'Connell, Bill Colgren, and Brian pursuant to recent complaints about O'Connell by some township residents. In the future, O'Connell may involve Board Members when dealing with irate property owners. John will notify the Board ahead of time about zoning violations. The Enforcement Officer will be Deputized in order to bring violators to court before a Judge.

Brian also introduced Matt Cooper from his firm who is running for ^{circuit} District Court Judge in the upcoming election. Cooper spoke briefly to those in attendance at the meeting.

Zoning Board Report-- Planning Commission, No Report

Ordinance Officer Report-- Mims is now 9 months out of date on his building permit. The Engle house location has been moved slightly from initial building permit location.

Clerk Report-- Pugsley commented on the August 7, 2012 election. Also he purchased an additional laser printer for under \$100.00.

Hospital Report-- The hospital is shooting for a net income of 2.7% this year. The hospital has scored a 97% satisfaction rate with patients. There is an audit coming up in September of the financial records.
