Regular Meeting Minutes
October 16, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor Jacque Phillippe. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, Bregger, and DeLeo.

Police Report-- No Report

Fire Report-- There were (14) calls in the Township. Calls year-to-date arfe 424. A new CPR dummy is needed.

Hospital Report-- An operating loss of \$739,000.00 was sustained in its last fiscal year. The hospital has received a clean audit report. October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month. The hospital is also collecting food donations.

Supervisor's Report-- The Board will be asked to pass a resolution to adopt the new BSA assessing software. This will create a network which will centralize tax receipts in the countywide computer system.

Clerk's Report-- The Clerk's printer has a non-fixable problem internally. The Clerk was advised to purchase a new laser printer to replace the damaged one.

Planning Commission-- The commission advises pursuing a demolition order on the Wallace Property by our Township Attorney. On October 23, 2013 there will be a public hearing on the proposed amendment to the Special use /section of the zoning in the Agricultural District/

Treasurer's Report-- Phil distributed Quaterly reports received from our accountant.
