

ARLINGTON TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
AUGUST 21, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor, Jacque Phillippe. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, Bregger, and DeLeo.

The minutes of the July 18, 2013 meeting were read. Motion by DeLeo supported by Pitts to approve the minutes. Motion Carried.

Police Report-- There were about (50) calls in the township. There have been increased road patrols to ticket drunk drivers.

Fire Report-- there were (47) calls with (7) in the township. (6 ) were medical with (1) accident. Derrick has received his new Chief's pickup and placed it in service.

Hospital Report--

Supervisor's Report-- The Guziak water run-off problem has been resolved by the County Road Commission.

Planning Commission Report-- John reported that there would be some work done on the Verizon Tower at the 28<sup>th</sup> Ave. site. The Building Inspector is moving ahead on condemning the structure on the Wallace property. He reported on some blight issues at Scott Lake. Mike Schrom was introduced to the Board as a willing replacement member of the Planning Commission. Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to place Mr. Schrom on the Planning Commission. Motion Carried.

Clerk Report-- Will reported that only (5) people voted in the August Lawrence School Election. It was suggested that we consult with the County Clerk about possibly consolidating future school elections into other townships.

Motion by Bregger supported by DeLeo to pay the bills. Motion Carried.

New Business-- We have contracted with GoDaddy.Com for an enhanced website with (5) email sites for Board members. We got a report on the progress of the township hall floor refinishing project. The project is running a little over budget. Motion by DeLeo supported by Pitts to increase the cost of the project by an additional \$500.00 if necessary. Motion Carried. Brian Knotek addressed the Board about a noise and large assembly ordinance which he said we already have in place. However, we should probably consider making some changes in our list of Special Uses of the Agricultural District so that it would include the current use of the former Judd property. Motion by Pitts supported by Pugsley to refer this matter back to the Planning Commission for review. Motion Carried. It was noted that there are several large pot holes in sections of 28<sup>th</sup> Ave that may require board action in order to get the Road Commission to make repairs.
