Regular Meeting Minutes  
October 15, 2014

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor, Jacque Phillippe. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, Bregger, and DeLeo.

The minutes of the September 17, 2014 meeting were read. Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to approve the minutes as read. Motion Carried.

Police Report-- No report. Still looking for new reserves. Still Pushing the new Smart 911 phone system.

Fire Report-- Lawrence-- A meeting to discuss the fire contract will be set up. The 1986 Fire Tanker is going to be replaced. The old unit is available for sale for \$30,000 dollars. The department is buying another thermal imaging camera with donations.

Bangor-- (4) medicals (1) assist (1) Fire call.

Supervisor Report-- Jacque read the Coloma ambulance report. She also commented on the Road Commission Culvert policy.

Clerk Report-- Pugsley commented briefly on the upcoming election.

Ordinance Report-- John commented on how much dumping is going on in the township.

Planning Commission Report-- Derrick Babcock is resigning from the commission. It was suggested that Joanna Padillo replace him. Motion by Pugsley supported by DeLeo to appoint Joanna Padilla to the Planning Commission. Motion Carried.

Attorney Report-- Several blight cases will be going to court. Fines and Fees increases were discussed. Several townships use double the Fee as the Fine. Knotek will consult other townships and report back. A solution to the Engle Home on CR 673 was discussed.

Hospital Report-- The recent Audit report is good. Hospital Staff recently met with Fred Upton to discuss the medical landscape. Nine new defibrillators are being purchased at a cost of \$130,000.00.

Commissioner Report-- A county budget of 21,381,000. which is balanced is being proposed. The county will receive \$134,000. From casino monies. 911 fees are going up to \$1.92 per month.

Senior Citizen Report-- DeLeo presented the Board with year end highlights report Participation by Arlington residents has increased quite a lot.
