

Arlington Township
Regular Meeting Minutes
June 18, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor, Jacque Phillippe. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, Bregger, and DeLeo.

The minutes of the May meeting were read. Motion by Pitts supported by Phillippe to approve as amended.

Police Report-- There were (28) calls in the township. There is a new 911 login process now in place for people to list information that could be accessed by Fire, Police, and Ambulance Departments.

Fire Report-- Bangor had (46) calls with (10) in the township. Saturday, July 5, Fireworks display will happen. The Department has reacquired its 1931 Reo Fire Truck. The department is also starting to work on the procurement of a new Tanker Truck.

Lawrence had (28) calls with (1) in the township.

Supervisor Report-- Residents report that Orchard Lane needs sealcoat.

Clerk Report-- The Election Board will meet soon to approve the election inspectors to be used in the upcoming election.

Planning Commission-- The commission would like to do a township wide survey on zoning issues like we did before revising our 5 year zoning plan.

Enforcement Office-- John is still working on a noise ordinance and a new fees and fines schedule.

Hospital Report--Patient satisfaction rate for April and May were 97% overall. Local participation by Arlington residents is increasing at the hospital.

Commissioner's Report--The county has received a clean audit report. A new phone system for the jail is needed. Van Buren Community Action has monies for those who qualify for home repairs.

Treasurer Report-- Summer Tax Collection will be starting soon. The new county software is user friendly.
