

Arlington Township Plan
Regular Meeting Minutes
July 16, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor, Jacque Phillippe. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, Bregger, and DeLeo. \

The minutes of the June meeting were read. Motion by Pitts supported by Phillippe to adopt the minutes. Motion carried.

Fire Report-- Bangor-- There were 38 calls with 7 in the township. Year-to-date calls are 253. The department is very close to putting out the bid package for the new fire truck.

Fire Report-- Lawrence-- there were 2 calls in the township neither being a fire. The department is reviewing its policies and procedures.

Police Report-- No report was available. A renewal millage for Public Safety is on the August 5 ballot.

Supervisor Report-- there will be an open house at the historical museum on July 27 between 1 and 5 p.m.

Clerk Report-- The state Primary Election will be held on August 5, 2014 The township is receiving FOIA requests from several commercial businesses. It would appear that we are being used as a data base for their research business. They are selling the information gleaned from townships all over the state.

Planning Commission-- No issues currently. The commission would like to do a township wide survey and are looking for the least expensive way of conducting it and who the survey should be targeted at.

Ordinance Office-- An inspection of the Mims house is scheduled for next week on Tuesday. John has talked with Mr. Engle about his house on blocks on CR 673. Motion by Pugsley supported by Pitts to have John speak with our attorney about what recourse the township would have in getting the house removed from the township if it is not installed on a foundation soon.

Hospital Report-- The fiscal year 2015 budget is projecting a 3% margin. The golf outing raised \$8000.00 more than last year. Most buildings within the hospital system are being renamed South Haven Health System wellness center etc.

Commissioner's Report-- none

Treasurer Report-- State Revenue Sharing is showing a loss to the township of around \$2200.00 Motion by DeLeo supported by Bregger to pay Atty. Knotek \$300.00 along with other bills. Motion Carried.
