Hospital Report-- The wellness center now has 2500 members. The visits for diabetic education is up. The overall satisfaction rating for the hospital is 92% . Urgent care saw 955 patients this past month.

County Commission Report-- Sue indicated that S&P has raised the County's credit rating to AA. Due to recent court rulings, the county court system may be losing \$700,000 per year.

Treasure Report-- A new office computer was recently purchased for \$549.00.
