Regular Meeting Minutes
March 18, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by supervisor, Jacque Phillippe. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, Bregger, and DeLeo.

The January and February minutes were read . Motion by Pitts supported b y Bregger to accept the minutes as amended. Motion carried.

Police Report--None

Fire Report- Bangor, There were 61 calls with 6 in the township. The new truck should be ready in June. The annual meeting of the Fire Board will be March 23, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.
Lawrence- the renewal contract is almost ready to be voted on.

Supervisor Report-- Discussion is ongoing with the learning center across the street about winter snow plowing. Jacque reports that 50th St north to 24th Ave. is in very bad shape. The 24th Ave bridge is closed. Frost laws are now in effect.

Hospital Report-- A new orthopedic surgeon will be joining the staff this summer. Over 300 cholesterol screenings were done at no charge this year. 3rd and 4th year residents from Bronson are now helping out in the ER department.

Clerk report-- Reminder that there will be a May 5 election with state and local items on the ballot.

Zoning -- John will be meeting soon with a resident on Hilltop Drive about a sewage problem. The zoning committee has received an application for a Special Use Permit for small engine repair. The hearing on this request will be conducted at their June 3, 2015 meeting. Survey results are being summarized. Arlington resident Larry Lear reported a loud music problem and is having a problem with the Sheriff's Dept. enforcing our noise ordinance. An August 15 deadline has been given to the Realtor handling the farm sale involving the Engle Home on blocks at the corner of 48th Ave. and CR 673. After that date the illegal structure must be removed from Arlington township.
