Regular Meeting Minutes  
February 17, 2016

The Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Board members present were Phillippe, Pitts, Pugsley, Bregger, and DeLeo.

Motion by Pitts supported by Bregger to adopt the January minutes as read. Motion carried.

Police Report-- None

Fire Report-- Bangor--52 calls with 10 in the township. The department has established a citizen complaint procedure. The annual report was then presented.

Hospital Report-- Finances remain bleak with losses in November and December. A contingency plan has been put in place to help reduce the losses. The Board has moved to find a partner for the hospital. If a partner is found it will take 50% plus 1 to dissolve the existing Hospital Authority.

Road Commission Report-- None

Commissioner's Report-- Beth Griffin, Commissioner, was present. The commission is reviewing more construction plans. The Board opposes treating 17 year olds as juveniles due to expense.

Senior Services Report-- there will be food truck give-aways on March 23, April 21, May 25, and June 16.

Planning Commission Report-- The entire board may undertake internet training seminars at a cost of \$1600.00.

Enforcement Report-- Mr. Mims needs a valid Class B used car dealer license. Letton Motor Sales on M-43 however, does not have a valid license and should be cited. An injunction will be sought for blight at the old Wallace property. There is still a problem with the Krugler building permit. The blight ordinance needs to be revised into a tougher ordinance. We should look into having a Deputy serve citations. Bangor-Arlington 425 Agreement-- Still looking for a signed copy of this document.

Noise Ordinance-- This will be tabled until a later date. Erin Williams will look into a neighborhood watch group that is getting active in other areas.

Clerk Report-- Presidential Primary will be held on March 8, 2016.

Signs for the new annex-- Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to purchase letters to be placed above the doorway not to exceed \$300.00. , Motion Carried

We need to get our fire extinguishers certified and tagged.

Beth Griffin spoke to the group as a candidate for Representative in the fall election.,

MTI Cleaning Contract-- A new cleaning contract for cleaning the new, larger hall and office complex was presented. The old hall and breezeway will be cleaned for \$50.00 each month. The new office complex and old hall will be cleaned every other month for an additional \$15.00 Motion by DeLeo supported by Pitts to accept the new contract. Motion Carried.
