

**Arlington Township  
Regular Meeting Minutes  
August 16, 2017**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor, Jacque Phillippe. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, DeLeo, and Melvin.

Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to accept the minutes as read. Motion Carried.

Police Report-- There were 45 calls in the township last month.

Fire Report--Lawrence---Mike reported that the department had received a grant in the amount of \$3300.00 to place reflective decals on equipment. Still changing lights in the firehall. There will be fireworks at the Ox Roast. The department insurance rating survey will be conducted soon.

Fire Report-- Bangor-- There were 36 calls with 7 in the township. Average response time is 3.56 minutes. On August 26 the circus will be in town. A pancake breakfast will be held on Labor Day.

Road Commission-- The county will be spraying county roadsides with herbicides.

Ambulance Report-- None

Commissioner Report-- The county has extended a lease for another 25 years on a tower which sits on county owned property. Commissioners approved a contract with POAM dispatchers. Budget for the coming year will be very similar to last year.

Seniors Report-- Food trucks will be at Paw Paw senior center on August 9 and December 13. Trucks will be at Hartford on October 11 and the Center in South Haven on November 8. Senior centers are now hosting yoga, painting classes,, computer classes, and have several short trips planned.

Ordinance Officer Report-- John will be meeting with the attorney the first week of September concerning upcoming court hearings. A gentleman addressed the Board voicing a problem with the township process server prowling around his house without permission. The Board expressed concern over this matter and told the gentleman that it would be addressed.

Supervisor Report-- There will be a Supervisors meeting next Thursday. The 44<sup>th</sup> Ave salt application has been reapplied. Next dump day will be September 9<sup>th</sup> from 8 am until 4 pm at the transfer station. Jacque would like to attend a seminar hosted by MTA in Frankenmuth. Motion by Pitts supported by Melvin to send her to the seminar at a cost not to exceed \$200 dollars. All members voted Yes. Motion Approved.

Treasurer Report-- The 2017 Fire Millage will be 2.8196 mills. Pitts moved supported by Pugsley to approve the Fire Levy of 2.8196 mills. All members voted yes. Motion Approved. Motion by Pugsley supported by Pitts to pay the bills. All members voted yes. Motion Approved.
