## ARLINGTON TOWNSHIP

## PROCEDURE FOR SEEKING A VARIANCE FROM A PROVISION OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE

- 1. This assumes that the applicant has submitted a zoning application seeking permission to take specific action to develop property.
- 2. If the property owner receives an adverse decision from the zoning administrator, the property owner may request a variance in the form and manner described in the Township Zoning Ordinance.
- 3. The request will go to the Zoning Board of Appeals ("ZBA").
- 4. The request shall be delivered to the Township Clerk in hard copy and electronic format, such as PDF.
- 5. The applicant shall pay all fees set by the Township.
- 6. The applicant shall follow all of the rules and procedures adopted by the ZBA.
- 7. The applicant shall provide any additional information requested by the ZBA.
- 8. The ZBA shall set a hearing on the request and the Township shall notify the applicant of the time and place of the hearing.
- 9. The ZBA shall determine whether the request will be granted in the form that is presented, or in a modified form.
- 10. The ZBA shall act at all times in conformance with the Township Zoning Ordinance and all relevant state statutes.
