Matt Butler called the meeting to order at 6:02 PM

Pledge of Allegiance led by Matt Butler

Roll Call: Ted Swanson, Bonnie Parmalee and Matt Butler all present

Others Present: Mr. and Mrs. Stephens, Ryan Laylin (Zoning Administrator), Township Residents

Mrs. Stephen 47578 Woodland Drive, Bangor, Mi. 49013 (80-03-009-00) explained that she wanted a variance to tear down the existing house on the property she bought and have a new one put in its place. According to the Arlington Township Ordinance, if the house was torn down, there would not be the required set backs for a new one. The current house is a non-conforming one. The house is 1300 sq. ft. Ryan Laylin asked if the house she wishes to put on the property is certified as a livable dwelling to which she responded in the affirmative.

A garage was also in the proposed changes but there is not enough room for that to be possible.

Ted Swanson questions if she would want to refurbish instead of demolishing. Mrs. Stephen said the quotes she received to do that were \$120,000 and \$180,000.

Ted Swanson made a motion to allow a variance for the Stephens to tear down their current house and to rebuild their house meeting all setbacks. Bonnie Parmalee supported the motion. If passed, the Zoning Administrator will make plans to meet with the Stephens at the site.
