The Van Buren County Drain Office is writing to inform you that maintenance work will soon be performed on the **Hunts Creek County Drain**, which may affect areas on or near your property.

This work is part of our ongoing responsibility to ensure the drain continues to function properly for stormwater conveyance and to reduce the risk of flooding and drainage issues within the watershed.

The Drain Commissioner has authorized a qualified contractor to complete this work. Anticipated activities may include, but are not limited to:

- Removal of brush and vegetation
- Sediment and debris removal

Please be advised that, in accordance with Michigan Drain Law (Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended), authorized personnel and equipment may need to access the drain through adjacent properties to complete this work. Every effort will be made to minimize disturbance.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we work to maintain the functionality of this important county drain.
